Warm up Procedures

Warm ups for all matches will be a 2-4-4-2 format, 2 minutes of ball handling, 4 minutes of individual time, 2 minutes of shared serving.

Total number of teams: 24 Varsity Teams- 12 Premier & 12 Classic

Tournament Format

Round One Pool Play

All pool matches will take place Friday night starting at 5:00 PM. There will be four three team pools. Last pool play match is scheduled to start at 7:00 PM.

Round Two Cross Pools

There will be six cross pool matches, per divisions. Teams who finish first or second in their pool will cross pool. All teams who finish 3rd in their pool will cross pool against each other. Cross pools 1-4 will take place Friday at 8:00 PM. Cross Pools 5 & 6 will begin Saturday at 8:00 AM.

Round Three Bracket Play

After the cross pools, the winner of Cross Pools 1-4 will advance to a four (4) team Gold Bracket. The loser of Cross Pools 1-4 will advance to a four (4) team Silver Bracket. All of the teams in Cross Pool 5 & 6 will advance to a four (4) team Bronze Bracket.

Play for all brackets will consist of 2 semi-final matches and a championship match for the top spot in that bracket. A consolation match for third and fourth place will also be played. Each team will be guaranteed five (5) matches.

General Tournament Information

Officiating Responsibilities

When **playing** each team must provide two people to work the table, or serve as a line judge. Dr. Phillips High School will provide as much assistance as possible.

Match Format

All matches are scheduled for one hour intervals. All pool play matches and bracket play match format is 2 games out of 3.

AWARDS

Each First and Second place teams in Gold Divisions will receive a team trophy. First and Second place teams in the Gold Division will receive individual medals.

Each First place finish in the Silver and Bronze, divisions will receive a plaque.

Tie Breakers

2 way ties will be decided based on head-to-head results.

There will be no tiebreaking matches; **3 way** ties will be decided in the following order:

- 1.) Won-Loss ratio for the total number of games played in the pool (wins/total games)
- 2.) Point Percentage (a team's total points scored divided by the total points scored by the opponents in that pool)
- 3.) Coin Toss
