**Saturday** will consist of pool play. (4) Pools of (4) teams per pool and (1) Pool of (3) teams

- (4) Team pools will be playing 2 out of 3 games per match. Round Robin.  
The first two games will be to 25 points rally score, win by two, no cap.  
The third game will be 15 points rally score, win by two, no cap.
- (3) Team pools will be playing 3 games 25 points,.

**Sundays'** play will consist of pool play. You will need to make sure you know where you finish on Saturday to determine your placement for Sunday's play.

**Mondays'** play will consist of a Gold, Silver, Bronze and Copper Single elimination tournament. Your finish in Sunday's pool will determine your placement for Monday's single elimination playoffs.

# TOURNAMENT INFORMANTION

## TEAM CHECK-IN

**FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00-8:00 PM AT OSC**

There will NOT be a coaches meeting on Friday night. However COACHES OR CLUB DIRECTORS MUST check in their teams (consists of signing the roster and picking up coaching credential pass.

## PLAYING SITES

Courts 1 through 12 are located at the Orlando Sports Center.

Courts 13 through 15 are located at Winter Springs High School

Courts 16 through 17 are located at Teague Middle School

**AM 8:00AM – 1:00PM      PM 3:00PM – 8:00PM**

## ADMISSION

This year's event will have an admission fee for spectators of \$5 per day

\*Athletes will just need to show their jersey to gain admission.

\*Teams will be issued a coaching credential pass for each coach listed on their roster

\*Spectators will be able to purchase a colored wrist band at the door each day at 7am,.

## WARM-UP

There will be no shared hitting during warm-ups.

The warm-up time will be as follows: 2-4-4: 2 minutes: both teams, ball handling, then 4 minutes for each team separately (4 minutes for one team to have whole court - 4 minutes for the opposing team to have the entire court, serving must be done in that time.)

## PROTESTS

If a protest is to be filed, it must be done at the time of the incident. NO LATER. The first referee is obligated to acknowledge and record all protests. **Only the floor captain may file protests.** (The exceptions to this are the 14 divisions and Under, where the acting team coach may act). The protest committee consists of Site Director, Sinee Snow or Ruth Montgomery and an official not involved in the protest.

## TOURNAMENT TEE SHIRTS

Tournament Tee Shirts will be on Sale at the OSC. Supplies are limited.

## TRAINERS

There will be a trainer available to tape ankles and assist with minor injuries at all sites.

# OFFICIATING RESPONSIBILITIES

We will provide a certified 1st referee for each match.

A rostered Adult must be in the score table area.

Each team is responsible for supplying 1 down official, 2 lines people, 1 scorekeeper, 1 visible scorekeeper and 1 Libero tracker. Each team must provide whistles. Failure to provide officiating for your next assigned match could result in a forfeit of the first game of your next match.

**For every minute your officiating team is late, 1 point is given to the opponent in your match, up to the 25-0 forfeit. No more than 25 points will be awarded to the team's next opponent, even if the team designed to officiate misses the entire match. The clock begins at the end of warm up.**

The second offense will result in the loss of your next match.

There will be certified 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nd referees for the finals in all age divisions.

## SEEDING

The tournament committee did all seeding for this event.

## MATCH AND FORFEITURE TIMES

The FIRST MATCH of any round or wave will not begin before its' scheduled time. **(Unless otherwise stated)**

Within a wave, a match may be advanced no more than ten (10) minutes from the scheduled starting time.

The last round of the wave may be advanced more than the specified 10 minutes if all participants are in agreement (includes both teams playing, and the officiating team).

The second game of the match is forfeited 10 minutes after the forfeiture of the first game.

## AWARDS

Each First and Second place teams in Gold Divisions will receive a team trophy.

First and Second place teams in the Gold Division will receive individual medals.  
Each First place finish in the Silver and Bronze divisions will receive a team award.

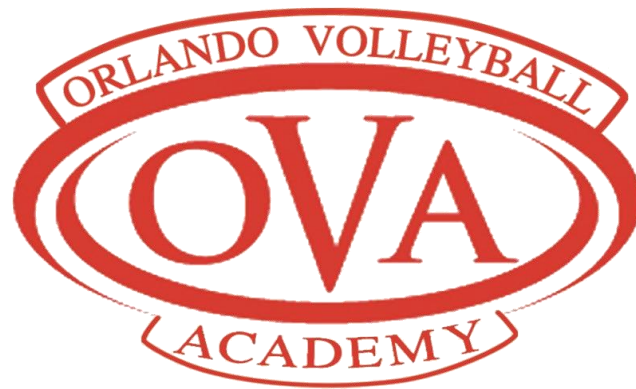
## TOURNAMENT POSTINGS

**Championship Desk is at The Orlando Sports Center**  
**All tournament results will be posted on Advanced Event System.**

The site Director will help you to know where you finish and help with the next day's placement. YOU are responsible to know where you go.

# FACILITY RULES

Due to incidents in previous years there will be a **NO TOLERANCE** policy this year for misbehavior by players/teams and spectators in the venues: Coolers **NOT ALLOWED** in the at OSC. Violation of these policies or any other general misbehavior may result in **IMMEDIATE** dismissal from the facility for the remainder of the day.



# TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES

All tie breaker games will be played at the end of each wave. Do not leave the gym if you are in a tie-breaking situation. Do not leave the gym until all pool play is finished. You could forfeit, if you leave before a tiebreaker.

It is each team's responsibility to determine their Saturday and Sunday finish and to report to any officiating responsibilities that they may have prior to their scheduled play on Monday. Failure to report to your appropriate court on Sunday or Monday will carry the penalties outlined in the officiating responsibilities. If you are in doubt, please check with the site director at your gym.

All Teams must be present to compete In the tie-breakers playoff games. If a team leaves the area this is considered a forfeit and they will be eliminated from the tie-breaker.

For all competition leading to the Gold Championships:

All two-way ties will result in head-to-head competition.

If there are more teams tied for playoffs than there are positions (three teams for two spots), the tied teams must compete for positions in direct competition. All tie-breaking games will be 1 rally game to 25 points, no cap with a 3/3 minute warm-up.

For all competition NOT leading to the Gold Championships:

There will be no playoff games. Teams will be seeded by match, game then point percentage for the next day.

**1. In a pool with two teams advancing and a 3-way tie in match record for 1<sup>st</sup>**

- a) The team with the best game/point percentage record will be ranked #1 in the pool and will ref a single tie-breaking game to 25 points between the other two teams.

**2. If there is a 3-way tie in the match record for 2nd place:**

If the 3-way tie breaking procedure eliminates a team from possibly reaching the Gold Championships, then tie-breaking games are required. In the event in which a 3-way tie for 2nd place exists, the seeds in the playoff are determined by:

- a. Win-Loss ration for the total number of games played in that pool
- b. Point percentage (a team's total points scored, divided by the total points scored by the opponents in that pool.)

The #2 seed will play the #3 seed, with the loser finishing fourth in the pool. The winner will play the #1 seed. The winner of this match will take 2nd place in the pool and the loser will take 3rd place.
